

Lynx Swamp Bulldogs For First Home Win

The Lynx earned a victory on their new field Friday night, September 27, by dumping Hampton 49 to 6.

By solding Webster City scoreless, the Bulldogs looked more impressive in the first quarter than at any time during the game. Lynx drives were hampered by fumbles and their defense didn't hold well.

Webster City fullback Tom Stepp scored in the second quarter after Denny Deischer blocked a Hampton punt on the 12 yard line. Later, Webster City took a Bulldog punt on their own 27. Jocko Hinderks raced 74 yards to make the score 14 to 0 at the half.

The home team controlled the

ball most of the second half. They took the ball on downs on the Bulldog 10. Stepp scored from 3 yards out. Hinderks later returned a punt from the 47 to the 18 and Ed Mulholland passed to Deischer for the TD.

The Lynx scored again on a Mulholland to Hinderks pass after Deischer recovered a Hampton fumble on the Bulldog's 25. Halfback Gilbert Tidman put Hampton in the scoring column with a 75 yard kickoff return.

Bud Brandt passed to Ron Dinsdale and Mike Jerde stole the ball from Hampton quarterback Greg Paullus to complete the scoring. All extra point attempts were good with Deischer kicking seven for seven.
